2 November 2009

SUBJECT: Minutes of SAME Fort Worth Post Board Meeting

- Minutes of the 5 October 2009 Board meeting were approved.
- The treasurer report indicates a balance of \$22,523.48 in the checking account and \$16,527.80 in a savings account. Total operating assets for the Post \$39,051.28. The Raymond Losornio Memorial Scholarship Fund inviolate principal is \$87,000.00. The Education and Mentoring Account has been invested with a balance of \$94,008.74. The total Post Education and Mentoring Assets are \$116,920.21.
- Individual membership is 487 with 120 members not included in our 80 Sustaining Firm membership. We currently have 56 Young Members.

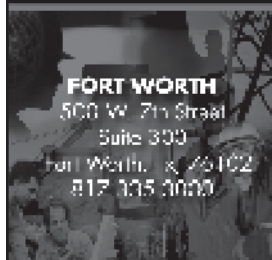
