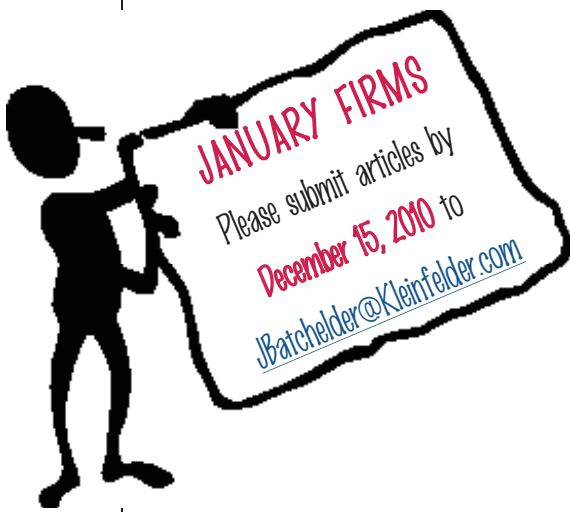

1 November 2010

- The treasurer report indicates a balance of \$25,209.17 in the checking account and \$16,645.89 in a savings account. Total operating assets for the Post \$41,855.06. The Raymond Losornio Memorial Scholarship Fund inviolate principal is \$87,000.00. The Education and Mentoring Account has been invested with a balance of \$102,568.64. The total Post Education and Mentoring Assets are \$129,568.64.
