JANUARY PROGRAM
Living With Levees In 2011

The levee question facing the nation involves searching for a balance between the need for modern flood maps that accurately reflect flood risk and the implications on locals of converting levee protected areas on these maps to flood hazard for those levee systems that are unable to achieve certification/ accreditation of their levees within FEMA’s timeframe. These compelling issues are discussed primarily from the viewpoint of the local affected levee owner/operator. State of Texas levee issues in four areas are presented; North Central, Gulf Coast, Fort Bend County and the Rio Grande River. These issues include a number of different problems. In North Central Texas, the cities of Dallas and Irving are struggling to push forward levee rehabilitation of the Dallas Floodway, a federal levee system. A number of large federal levee districts along the Texas Coast have been in limbo pending the completion of the Texas Gulf Coast Surge Study by the Corps and FEMA, now scheduled for December 2010. Many expect that some of the existing levee systems will have insufficient freeboard when the new surge data is incorporated into the DFIRM Update. Fort Bend County has 17 nonfederal levee systems. Many have banded together in a flood management association to share information and present a unified response. Levees along the American side of the Rio Grande River are owned, operated and maintained by the US International Boundary and Water Commission. The USIBWC is actively rehabilitating miles of levees and has compliance accreditation efforts underway with FEMA. Lastly, an ongoing (three years to date) levee compliance experience of a small district is examined in some depth.



This presentation will discuss important “lessons learned” for both local and federal floodplain managers involved with levee safety issues. For example, the impacts on local districts of the evolving federal process, especially technical criteria and reviews, are discussed. If schedules hold, the impacts of the new surge data on Texas Coastal levee districts will be known and presented in terms of past and future actions by these levee owners.
